Executive Order DB 27

Relating to the Creation of the Texas Council for Input on Crime, Rehabilitation and Prevention

Whereas, the State of Texas recognizes the continuing increase in crime and criminal activity by adults and juveniles; and

Whereas, the continuing increase in crime and criminal activities by adults and juveniles involves state and local governments, a broad spectrum of state agencies, and local agencies and organizations, all of which are responsible for planning and budgeting to achieve the delivery of services; and

Whereas, the Governor of the State of Texas as the chief planning officer of the state desires and needs broad-based input to the causes and effects of crime and criminal activity by adults and juveniles, ongoing activities and results of rehabilitation of adults and juveniles, and ongoing activities and results of programs to prevent juvenile delinquency to assist in the total planning for state and local governments, state agencies and local agencies and organizations;

Now, therefore, I, Dolph Briscoe, by the power vested in me do hereby establish the Texas Council for Input on Crime, Rehabilitation and Prevention.

The purpose for the Texas Council for Input on Crime, Rehabilitation and Prevention is to report to the governor at least annually in a form and manner determined by the governor on:

- (1) causes of crime and criminal activities by adults and juveniles and to propose new concepts and programs to reduce crime and criminal activity by adults and juveniles;
- (2) ongoing activities and results of rehabilitation for adults and juveniles and to propose new concepts and programs to increase the effectiveness of rehabilitation of adults and juveniles; and
- (3) ongoing activities and results to prevent juvenile delinquency and to propose new concepts and programs to increase the effectiveness of programs to prevent juvenile delinquency.

The governor shall appoint the necessary number of knowledgeable persons to the Texas Council for Input on Crime, Rehabilitation and Prevention to provide a broad-based representation for the desired and needed input.

All state officials' and employees' services shall be additional duties of their respective offices.

All members of the Texas Council for Input on Crime, Rehabilitation and Prevention shall serve at the pleasure of the governor.

This order is effective on the 1st day of April, 1976.
