July 21 - 1840

Dear Mary

Col Johnson was sent for by the
Committee after hearing that you had embarked
on the Cam. He has just left here after
seeing the specimens of the Cam. that you
were as likely to employ some person to
go with and assist you, & who would be
allowed all travelling & board such as
stage fare, Steamboat &c. and in addition,
in lieu of personal expenses, $2\frac{1}{2}$ \$ a day,
all of which you will pay & be allowed
for.

The only letter you will get is the one
Mr Wells will send you from Louisville,
but written with the Committee's approbation &
at his request, in my presence.

All is right now - Mr Wells shall
have Col Johnson's letter this evening. He
requests to set off tomorrow & join you
at Wheeling. With my best wishes for
your prosperity, I am your friend
