A reference to the table of remittances sent on the 28th ult for the Creeks Indians, you will perceive, a retention of a moiety of their regular annuities, amounting to \$17,250. for payment next Spring. On reflection I have thought it would be more satisfactory to them to pay the whole amount for the present year, and commence the Semi-annual payments with the annuities of next year.

There will therefore be remitted to you from the Treasury the above amount, under the head of "Fulfilling treaties with Creeks"
