Sir:

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 28<sup>th</sup> November last, enclosing for approval, a license granted by Agent Cooper to Charles S. Wright & Co, to trade with the Chictaws, together with accompanying papers.

The bond appears to have been executed on the 1<sup>st</sup> of March 1856, and the license granted on the 17<sup>th</sup> of March of the same year; - the execution of the bond bearing date, prior to that of the license upon which it is based, is evidently a mistake, and these papers are herewith returned, that the necessary corrections may be made.
