A letter has been received at this office from Agent Horn, of date the 28th ultimo, stating that the Dupaws are desirous of selling a portion of their lands to the Government, to which I would reply, and you will so inform Mr Horn, that no action will be taken by the Department upon this subject, until it shall be informed of what action was had by the Senate in regard to the Article of Agreement and Convention which were entered into with the Dupaws on the 12th of August 1854, and submitted to that body.
