Sir;

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of 30th ultimo, enclosing one from Agent Dorn upon the subject of intrusions upon the Reserve of the New York Indians in Kansas Territory.

In reply I have to inform ^{you} that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs is now enroute on an official visit to various Indian Agencies in Kansas and Nebraska, and that among others, he contemplates visiting that at Neosho. It will therefore be proper for you to apprise Agent Dorn thereof, in order that he may be prepared to bring the matter before the Commissioner for his personal investigation.
