Sir:

I have the honor herewith to transmit the Census roll of those Creek Indians, or their descendants who emigrated west of the Mississippi river prior to the Treaty of 1832, and who are entitled to participate in the 120,000 dollars provided for in the 7th Art of Treaty of 7th August 1856, as taken and approved by the General Council of the Creek Nation.

By reference to the instructions given to Supt. Rector by the Secretary of Interior of date 10th April 1857, I cannot see that it was the intention of the Secretary that this roll should be forwarded to you before the payment of the money to the Indians, but as Supt. Rector is absent I comply with the request of Agent Gassie, who deposited the roll in this office with request that it be forwarded to you for your action.
