Sir:

By my letter from the Chief Clerk of the  
 Court of the District of Minnesota of the 21<sup>st</sup> inst. informing  
 that the Chief Clerk of the Court has been on the 9<sup>th</sup>  
 inst for the day to the Court and that any order for  
 by the Court of the 22<sup>nd</sup> inst. was made during of 1852  
 I left Minn. to a few days since in the  
 of Councils known as the Bureau. The Chief Clerk of the  
 Chief Clerk of the Court, when he has been ordered to take  
 in the Court a certain number of the Bureau  
 of the Indians in the State of Minnesota on the Bureau  
 Indians, also to select the land for the Agency for the  
 Bureau, district, he is now engaged in the removal  
 and location of these Indians, and I am un-  
 able to say at what time he will return, he has  
 not known himself when I left him, the Court has  
 been by the time for the payment of the money from him
