June 6<sup>th</sup> - 46.

Sir

I rec'd early last winter a line from you by the hand of Genl. Rains, by which I was informed of your compliance with my request in submitting my claim against the Osages to their Sub Agent for examination.

At the time I rec'd your letter two of my material witnesses were absent, one in the north of Missouri, and the other in Illinois, and before I could get all together, I was told, that Sub Agent was about to leave to Nation, this was the first of April, I then went to N. Orleans, am just returned, and learn that a new Sub Agent has been appointed for the Osages.

The object of this therefore, is to inform you of those facts, and request you to authorize the present Sub Agent for the Osages, to re-examine my claim as the former might have done had he been there -
