Your letter dated Sept. 27 - '47 - informing me of the complaint of Bob Grayson (a Creek Indian) against a Quapaw for stealing his horse &c was recd on 10<sup>th</sup> Oct. last. A enquiry immediately made if anything was known of it by the Seminoles.

Nothing was elicited at the time, nor have I heard since, but should I learn when he is - your instruction will be attended to.
