Sir: I send by Mr Page several letters - also transmitted several by Mr Hadden. We have no mail facilities here at this time -

My Accounts are all ready for settlement. They are very bulky - the Choc<sup>o</sup> & Chickasaw Rolls being very large. Page cannot take them home back and I am afraid to trust them to the mail. I have under the circumstances, it will be excusable to take them with me to some safe point for mail -

The Chickasaw Legislature appropriated also the \$20000 "Seam Fund" and directed the money to be paid - part to the Treasurer of the Nation & part to Edmund Pickens
